Kitchen in the sky

Miami designer Fede Terán takes an outdated kitchen high above Brickell Avenue to an even higher level.

hirce days after buying a 3,000-square-foot condoon the 32st Boor of a Brickell Avenue skyscraper. an energetic South American couple with three daughters hired Fede Teran to overhand their entire outdated space. Teran, a Venezuelan-born designer with a background in marketing and the music entertainment industry, tapped into his very-Miami core design stance as inspiration: "Why live simply if you can live fantastically?" he says, noting that you need not invest a lot of money in order to do so, rather "just beaware of the possibilities you have." He practiced precisely these principles as he took the couple's 650-square-foot kitchen from shabby to chie. "If you turn right, if you turn left, if you look North." he says, "I wanted the kitchen to look fabulous. Every part."

Before, the closed-off theu-contemporary space was outfitted with light bardwood floors, painted walls and Corian countertops. "It was a sad kitchen, so I needed to bring it to life," Teransaid. To revive the space, he opened it up by removing the walls and replacing the floors with large; low-maintenance tiles of rectified porcelain he had imported from Italy. Next, he created an island in the center of the kitchen and a breakfast area, appointed with pops of pear-colored barstools, looking out onto sturning panoramic views of the city in the morning.

As avid contemporary art collectors, the owners wanted a certain artistry that reflected their modern style. So Teran breathed a more contemporars air into the kitchen by mixing and matching colors and freshening up the palette. A cleau, off-white quartz countertop with expresso cabinets is in the main space; and on the island, laxurious espresso quartz with off-white cabines try gives the eye some play. The cabinetry, a mix of dark wood and enstom-made taupe glass with scraped lines, adds a dash of mod.

To effortlessly blend this all while maintaining a clean; simple look, Teran hid appliances behind

cabinetry. The refrigerator, for example, sports the same sleek glass paneling as the upper calinets: and the dishwasher, sitting to the left of the sink. is covered in the dark cabinet panels. But the undisputed star of the kitchen is the beautiful backsplash, handmade Murano glass tiles imported from Italy. A high relief chocolate-colored mosaic that flows across the wall, it brings in texture and, glowing under the LED lights, elegantly ties the other elements together.

Togetherness. Teran says that's what the kitchen is all about. For his clients, being able to host large family gatherings here was as important as any stylish element. It's something he can relate to on a most personal level, something he says he constantly thought about while designing the kitchen. "When I was growing up, living my with my morn and dad, the best times were in the kitchen," he reminisces. "It's a special place, Everyone is happy in it... it's warm, it's cozy, and you're just enjoying family time."

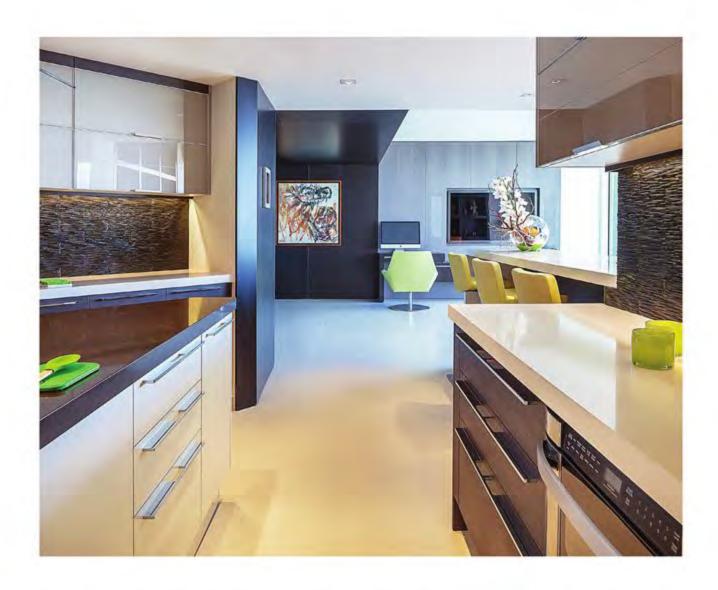
